Monte Vista Christian School welcomes students of talent and motivation. Payment plans, in addition to scholarships and financial aid, are available to help manage the cost of tuition.

**New Student Application Fee:**  
 \$80...by mail      *This (non-refundable) fee is charged for each new student upon application for admission. The fee covers screening and processing of the application.*

**Returning Student Enrollment Fee:**  
 \$400...(until) Feb. 17      *This (non-refundable) fee is charged for each student every year at MVCS and must be returned with the enrollment contract to secure placement.*

A Monte Vista Christian School education is an investment in your child's future. Our students come to us from a wide range of socio-economic backgrounds; we strive to keep fees to a minimum while still providing a quality educational program. In comparison to other independent schools, our day student fees are low. Additionally, we provide a built-in financial aid program for families with more than one student enrolled at MVCS. We maintain the highest of standards in the quality of our faculty, programs, and facilities.

Our programs and budget are established in June according to the number of enrolled students. Students are admitted to MVCS for the entire school year, therefore we make no allowances for refund under any circumstances. Should the event of withdrawal for any reason, including both voluntary withdrawal and dismissal, become necessary you are financially responsible for all tuition and fees through the semester of withdrawal.

**Early payment discount:** If 100% of the tuition and fees are paid on or before July 1, 2012, families will receive a \$300 per student discount.

**Second Semester Enrollments:** If a student enrolls at any time during the first semester, the full enrollment fee will be charged; a second semester enrollee will be charged 50% of the enrollment fee.

**iPads:** all students are required to have an iPad. iPads are available for checkout at the beginning of the year, and returned at the end of the year. If a student checks out an iPad, an insurance policy is required.

**Miscellaneous Fees:** Additional costs may be incurred by the student for special activities such as field trips, athletics fees, physical education uniforms, and library fines. There are additional fees for the Academic Assistance Program, Equestrian Program, ESL, or Transitional English classes.

**Textbooks:** A set of textbooks is purchased separately by the family for home use. A second set of textbooks will be provided by MVCS for use in the classroom. Classroom books may not be removed from campus.

**Bus Transportation:** The bus transportation fees and bus schedules are available from the Transportation Office at (831) 722-8178 ext. 181 or on our website at [www.mvcs.org](http://www.mvcs.org). Bus fees are charged through FACTS tuition management, or paid in full at the Business Office.

**Returned Checks:** If a check is returned, a fee of \$25 will be assessed to your student billing account. A replacement payment must be made in cash or cashier's check within 5 days. After a second returned check, all payments must be made in cash, by credit card, or by cashier's check.
