ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE: \$3,750

ESL is required for students whose TOEFL score is between 425 and 475.

TRANSITIONAL ENGLISH: \$1,250

Transitional English is required for students whose TOEFL score is between 475 and 550.

STUDENT MEDICAL INSURANCE

Domestic students–

Evidence of medical insurance coverage acceptable by local physicians and hospitals must be provided to the admissions office prior to the student moving into the dormitory.

International students–

The school provides a Blue Cross PPO policy for international students (F-1 visa only) as part of tuition, room and board.
