

Middle School Complex: This has evolved over a long period as needs have changed. M1, M2, M3 and M4 are buildings that were acquired from military surplus. The Middle School office has grown from the old tool shed/chicken house from behind the Sailer's home; it has been remodeled and enlarged a couple of times. The newest Middle School building is M7 through M10 and was built in 1987. M11 and M12 are in the Quonset hut next to the kitchen and M13, the most recent acquisition of Middle School classrooms, was previously the snack bar, and before that, it was an old barn.

Kitchen/Dining room: This was built in 1947 and has undergone several changes throughout the years. The staff dining room was remodeled in the summer of 1994. In the kitchen, there are new ovens and griddle, vinyl flooring, new refrigeration for the walk-in freezer, reconditioned the freezers interior and rebuilt the pantry laundry area in the kitchen itself. The dining room receives regular maintenance on its interior.

Middle School Gymnasium: This building was erected from a quonset style building. It includes a standard size basketball court, locker rooms and restrooms.

High School Gymnasium: This gym was built in 1984. The locker rooms were finished in 1989 and upgraded in '94 and '96. The weight room was completed in 1994-95. Four classrooms, including the computer lab occupy the south end of the upstairs of the gym.

Equine Buildings: The equestrian area includes a hay barn about 10 years old, a horse barn with 10 stalls, and a tack room which is about 12 years old, and several smaller outbuildings. The classroom was originally the milking parlor in the early days of Monte Vista. The equestrian area is laid out like a small western town around the English arena.

Modular Building: This was purchased in 1995. The building itself is ten years old. It includes two classrooms with central heat and air conditioning making for very comfortable rooms.

Residence Halls: The boys' residence hall was built in 1960 and 1963. Another addition in 1974 included half of the first floor, the upper floor and the dean's apartment.

The girls' residence hall was also built in two stages. The residences were built first in 1968, with plans for another wing to the west of the present dormitory. The second stage in 1983 was the building of the lobby and center walkway going through the middle of the dorm. The dean's apartment was built at this time.

Music Building: The music building was built of cinder blocks in 1952 and was used as the print shop. It was converted to be a music building in the late 1970's. The roof and porch have been replaced this year along with the entry sidewalks and retaining walls.

Old Art Lab: This is the oldest classroom on campus. It is one of the original Monte Vista Ranch buildings and at one time was the garage where all the mechanic work was done. Still at one end is the pit for working on trucks and cars (covered up). The old building will be replaced when the chapel/performing arts center is constructed.

Bus Barn: The bus barn was built in 1981. It accommodates one bus at a time and is a great improvement over the old bus barn (which can still be seen at M13).

Woodshop: The woodshop was built in 1950. It is a frame building with a tin roof and lean-to shed on the side covered with fiberglass roofing. It was a surplus military building moved from Stockton and reassembled.

Warehouse: The warehouse was a building in Salinas which was purchased, disassembled, moved to MV with the help of students in 1964-66, and it was reassembled at its present site with the help of students, staff and friends.

Auto Shop: This is a Quonset hut of the same vintage as M11 and M12. It was also military surplus reassembled by staff and students.
