Monte Vista Christian School's Response to COVID-19

Monte Vista Christian School serves over 850 students and families spanning four counties, as well as over 100 employees. We are also unique in that we are home to over 75 boarding students and nearly 30 on-campus staff members and their families. As a result, our decision-making process differs significantly from those of surrounding schools.

With this responsibility of care in mind, we are making proactive decisions to:

- **Hold classes as planned both tomorrow and Friday (March 12-13).**
- **Give students a three-day weekend (no school on Monday, March 16),** so that our faculty have another professional development day of planning.
- **Suspend all fine arts and athletic practices/events,** starting Monday, March 16.
- Continue **uninterrupted care for boarding students** on campus in dormitories under the supervision of ResLife staff.
- Move to **remote learning beginning Tuesday, March 17 until Easter Break begins on Saturday, April 4.**
- **Enjoy Easter Break as previously scheduled** from Saturday, April 4 through Monday, April 13; as is the policy with all MVC breaks, students will not be assigned homework during Easter Break.

Our hope is to resume on-campus learning and extracurricular activities at the conclusion of Easter Break on Tuesday, April 14.
